Sisterhood Catering provides a service to our synagogue families and is a fundraising source for Congregation Beth El. The committee members are all volunteers. Each B-Mitzvah family is required to participate in the serving of a kiddush. This experience is a wonderful opportunity to see how the kiddush is prepared and to participate in the excitement of the congregation's life cycle events. Serving at a kiddush builds our sense of community at Beth El.

You can pick your own date to do this mitzvah for other families. Each B-Mitzvah child and one parent/guardian need to sign up but other family members are welcome to help as well (if they are old enough to handle food service). We encourage you to do this before the date of your B-Mitzvah but it can be done any time in the year your simcha occurs.

Signing up is easy! Visit www.bethelmc.org/kiddush and click on the large blue button to select a date that works for your family. Simply provide your names and email address and look forward to doing one of the happiest mitzvot at Beth El.

On the date you choose, you will need to arrive at the kiddush by 11:45 am. Check in with the Sisterhood Catering Volunteer who will provide you with an apron and assign you to a table. You will serve until about 15 minutes after the service ends. If you enjoy the experience, we encourage you to sign up again anytime.
