

CEMETERIES

There are several Jewish cemeteries in the Washington area. Those listed are the most commonly used by our members. Beth El has synagogue sections at Judean Memorial Gardens and Garden of Remembrance. Contact Executive Director Heather Garrett if you are interested in purchasing a plot at either of these locations.

Garden of Remembrance, Gan Zikaron Memorial Park 301-428-3000

14321 Comus Road, Clarksburg MD 20871

Beth El has a large section of continuous plots for purchase by members. All plots allow for either upright headstones or flat grave markers. There is also an area for interfaith family members.

Judean Memorial Gardens, Norbeck Memorial Park 301-384-1000

16225 Batchellors Forest Road, Olney MD 20832

Beth El has a large section of continuous plots for purchase by members. Plots in the Beth El section can only have flat grave markers.

King David Memorial Gardens, National Memorial Park 703-560-4400

7400 Lee Highway, Falls Church VA 22040

This Jewish section of National Funeral Home and Memorial Park was once popular with Beth El members.

Mt. Lebanon Cemetery, George Washington Cemetery 301-434-4640

9500 Riggs Road, Adelphi MD 20783

Less often used by Beth El members.

Menorah Gardens, Parklawn Memorial Park 301-881-2151

12800 Veirs Mill Road, Rockville MD 20848

Not commonly used by Beth El members.

It is wise to purchase a plot before it is actually needed as it relieves the family of a difficult decision if death comes unexpectedly. In addition to the plot itself, it is also necessary to purchase services for the actual interment, liner, installation, etc. These arrangements are made directly with the cemetery.

Each cemetery has its own specifications for a monument so it is important to check with the cemetery first. You can order a monument from the cemetery, or work with a private company.
